- Applicants must ensure that all information and documents submitted are accurate and genuine. Any discrepancy may result in cancellation of admission.
- The applicants is committed to completing the admission process in a timely and transparent manner. Applicants are requested not to send repeated queries regarding application status and to allow sufficient time for verification.
- Applicants and their parents/guardians are advised to follow only official communications issued by SIMT. The Institute shall not be responsible for information obtained from unofficial sources.
- Students whose admissions are confirmed after fee submission shall be required to attend the Oriented Programs, Classes, Practical, other academic activities as notified by the Institute.
- SIMT advised Students to insure that they complete their selected courses.
- The Institute follows a transparent admission process. Applicants should not make any payment to any individual claiming to

facilitate admission. All fees must be deposited only through the official channels approved by the Institute.

- SIMT reserves the right to verify academic records and supporting documents from the issuing authorities whenever required.
