

Internal Assessment Rules

Internal Assessment Weightage

For most PTU-affiliated programs offered at SIMT (MBA, BBA, BCA, B.Com, B.Voc, etc.):

Component	Marks
Internal Assessment (Sessional)	40
University External Examination	60
Total	100

For practical subjects, the internal and external distribution may vary according to the university scheme of study.

Components of Internal Assessment

The internal assessment is based on **continuous evaluation** throughout the semester. Marks are generally awarded through:

- Mid Semester Tests (MST-I/II)
- Assignments
- Class Performance
- Attendance
- Practical/Lab Work (where applicable)

PTU regulations specifically require continuous evaluation and a minimum of two class tests during the semester.

PTU Distribution Pattern

PTU pattern for internal assessment is:

Activity	Weightage
MSTs	20
Assignments / Presentations	10
Attendance	10
Total Internal Assessment	40

Attendance marks are often awarded progressively based on attendance percentage.

Passing Requirements

Students are required to secure:

- Minimum **40% marks** in the subject overall.
- Minimum **40% marks separately** in:
 - Internal Assessment (Sessional)
 - External Examination

Students must maintain regular attendance.

Important PTU regulations followed by affiliated colleges include:

- Appear in all **MSTs** and internal tests.
- Submit **assignments** on time.
- Minimum **75% attendance** is generally required.
- **Attendance** directly contributes to internal assessment marks.
- Complete **practical files and lab work** where applicable.
