Student Discipline and Code of Conduct

All students of SIMT are expected to maintain discipline, respect, and good behavior both inside and outside the campus. Any act that disrupts the academic environment or damages the reputation of the institution may lead to disciplinary action.

1. General Discipline

- Students must obey the rules and regulations of the Institute.
- Students should behave respectfully towards faculty members, staff, and fellow students.
- Any form of misconduct, indiscipline, abusive language, bullying, harassment, or rude behavior will not be tolerated.

2. Classroom Conduct

- Students must maintain silence and discipline during classes.
- Disrupting lectures, creating disturbances, or engaging in disorderly behavior is prohibited.
- During free periods, students should utilize the library, reading room, or designated study areas responsibly.
- Mobile phones should be kept on silent mode during classes and academic activities.

3. Campus Environment

- Students must help maintain a clean, peaceful, and academic atmosphere on campus.
- Loitering unnecessarily in corridors, offices, classrooms, or restricted areas is discouraged.
- Smoking, consumption of alcohol, tobacco products, drugs, or any prohibited substances within the campus is strictly forbidden.

4. Protection of Institute Property

- Students must take proper care of classrooms, laboratories, library resources, furniture, equipment, and all institute property.
- Any damage, defacement, or misuse of institute property will result in recovery of repair/replacement costs and disciplinary action.

5. Vehicle Parking

- Vehicles must be parked only in the designated parking areas.
- Students should lock their vehicles properly.
- SIMT will not be responsible for any loss, theft, or damage to parked vehicles.

6. Student Activities and Events

- No club, society, event, meeting, or student group may be formed or organized without prior approval of the Principal/Director.
- Inviting guests, speakers, or external participants to the campus requires prior written permission from the Institute authorities.

7. Health and Safety

- Students suffering from contagious or infectious diseases should avoid attending classes until medically fit.
- Students must follow all health, safety, and emergency guidelines issued by the Institute.

8. Examination Integrity

- Cheating, copying, impersonation, use of unfair means, or assisting others in malpractice during examinations is strictly prohibited.
- Any student found involved in examination malpractice may face cancellation of examination, suspension, or expulsion as per University and Institute rules.

9. Identity Card

- Every student must carry their SIMT Identity Card while on campus.
- The Identity Card must be produced whenever requested by authorized staff.
- Unauthorized persons are not permitted to enter the campus without approval.

10. Disciplinary Action

Violation of any of the above rules may result in one or more of the following actions:

- Verbal or written warning
- Monetary fine
- Suspension from classes or institute activities
- Restriction from using institute facilities
- Debarment from examinations

- Expulsion from the Institute

The decision of the Principal/Director regarding disciplinary matters shall be final and binding.
